The body is incredibly soft, full-bodied and very harmonious, with an unforgettably long finish.

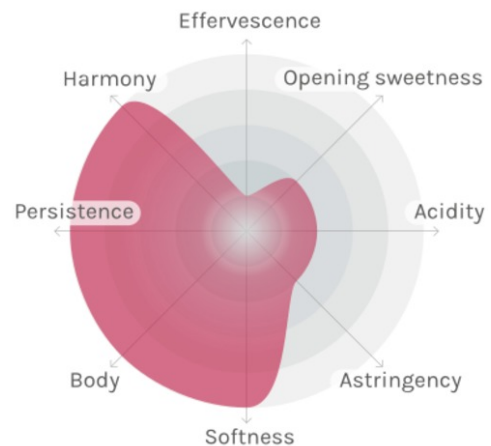
