

Weingut Stadt Krets

The town of Krets is situated in a basin at an altitude of approx. 220 metres above sea level. The vineyards feature two types of soil: gneisses are ideal for Riesling, while loess soils give the Grüner Veltliner its flavour and structure. Two climate zones come together at this point: in the west an oceanic climate with mild winters and moderately warm summers, in the east a pannonic climate with very cold winters and dry summers. This results in stark temperature differences between day and night within a confined space, balanced out by the Danube. These extremes define the vegetation, providing the perfect basis for fruity wines with an intense bouquet.
