### Character

Well balanced, fruity, rich and long-lasting, this typical Amarone is garnet-red in the glass, with a few purple reflections. Its medium-weight bouquet brings aromas of prunes, figs and raisins, with further notes of stone fruit and berries. On the palate it is slightly sweet, fresh and aromatic - soft, full-bodied and harmonious. Here again it reveals its notes of berries and dried fruit, with additional hints of clove, pepper and toast, and a pleasing finish.


