A wonderfully complex, elegant, mellow and well-structured wine. On the nose are intense aromas of ripe plums and cassis, complemented by intriguing roasted notes. Its pastry and sweet spice notes, together with a hint of caramel, are enchanting. On the palate, its slight initial sweetness and velvety soft tannins harmonise perfectly with the aromatic elements. It has a lively and lengthy finish.

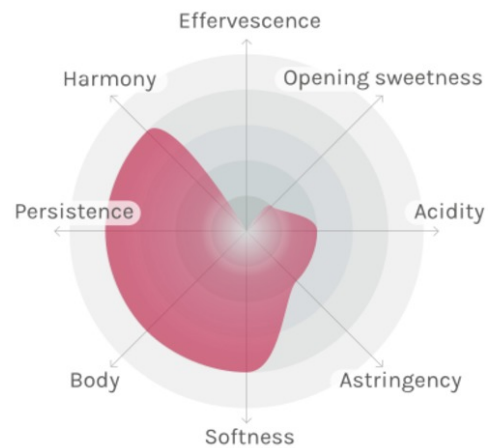
