Château de la Gardine

The Château de la Gardine plays an important role in the reputation of the Châteauneuf-du-Pape appellation. The Brunel family has been growing wine here since 1670, but it was only after World War II that Gaston Brunel founded today's estate. It spans 55 hectares of the Châteauneuf-du-Pape and Côtes-du-Rhône Villages appellations. A few years ago, the Brunel family took over Château Saint-Roch in Rocquemaure, one of the best producers of the Lirac appellation, on the Western bank of the Rhône.
