The Maremma plain in southern Tuscany is a relatively young wine region. It is here that Federica Masceroni Stianti from the great Chianti winegrowing family of Castello di Volpaia has put herself on her own feet with the Prelius winery. With great care and commitment she produces elegant, Mediterranean-inspired organic wines. Thanks to the unique terroir - sandy sedimentary soils at only 30 to 50 m a.s.l. - and due to the typical microclimate with its mild winters and hot summers, the vines ripen perfectly and yield smooth, aromatic and fruity wines.


