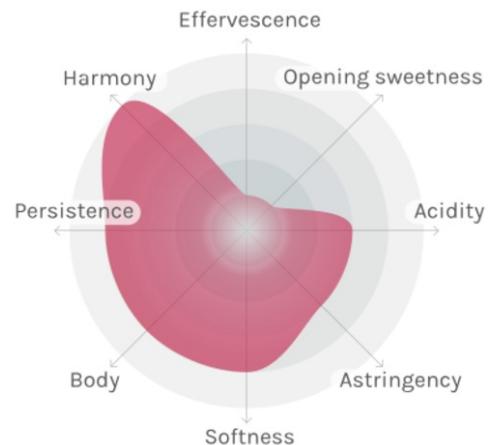

The Parusso family of Piedmontese winegrowers is passionately dedicated to advancing viticulture in the Alba region - with a wine that bears the name of the town. Production of Vegliamonte Alba DOC revives time-honoured traditions, at the same time combining them with innovative new techniques. The wine is composed of at least 85% Nebbiolo and 15% Barbera - a traditional blend that balances the Nebbiolo character with that of Barbera: it is called 'Taglio all'albese'. The grapes are carefully harvested by hand in small baskets and processed using modern methods to produce an excellent, contemporary wine.
