Whoever uses the Governo method to produce a superior wine like II Chiarone must know exactly what they are doing. For the original, traditional system must be learned, and its implementation demands skill and patience. After harvesting, a portion of the grapes are dried in order to increase the sugar content. When alcoholic fermentation has been completed, juice from the raisins is added to the wine, thereby restarting fermentation. The makers of II Chiarone have recognised the potential of Governo and understand how, with great care and patience, the full aroma of a unique wine can be perfectly manifested.
