Character

A fresh, fruity, semi-sweet, rich and light white wine, pale yellow in colour, very lively, soft and harmonious, with an impressive fullness. It has an enjoyably powerful and complex bouquet with aromas of lychee and muscatel, complemented by citrus fruit (mandarin), pear, peach and a touch of strawberry and blueberry. A marked sweetness is evident initially, with regular perlage and a subtle mousse, while its appealing fruitiness continues onto the palate, rounded off by hints of nutmeg, vanilla and light candy notes.
