This deep red wine is a delight, with a fruity bouquet of plum and sour cherry, complemented by slight notes of biscuit and caramel. On the palate, these aromas are joined by the light berry notes of cassis and blueberry, together with some dried fruit and leathery dimensions. The wine is fresh, with pleasing tannins, a very soft, full-bodied and incredibly harmonious body, and a sustained finish.

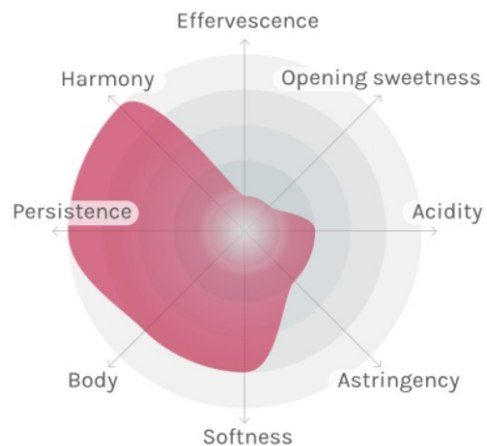

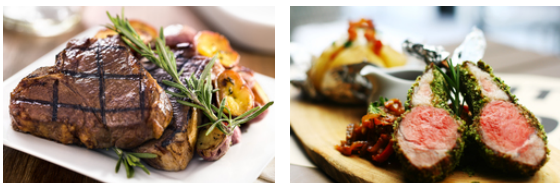
