With great care and commitment she produces elegant, Mediterranean-inspired organic wines. Thanks to the unique terroir - sandy sedimentary soils at only 30 to 50 m a.s.l. - and due to the typical microclimate with its mild winters and hot summers, the vines ripen perfectly and yield smooth, aromatic and fruity wines.
