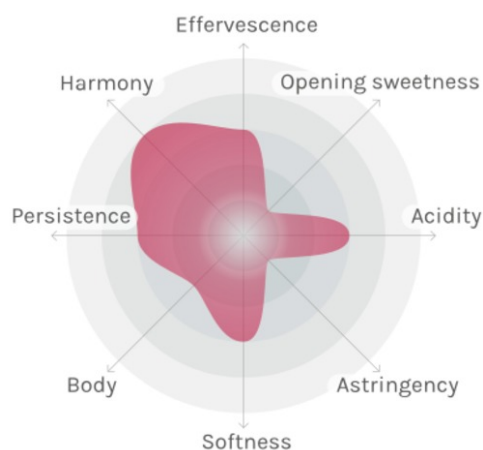

As dynamic, wild and free as their name-giver, the exclusive wines of the Mendoza-based establishment are by nature imbued with an honest character, a big personality, elegance and expression. Aurelio Montes, a pioneer of carefully prepared wines in Argentina, received a series of prestigious awards for his wines as well as his lifetime achievement.
